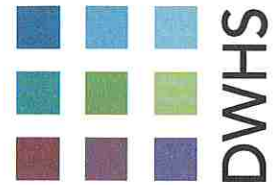

At the beginning of 2018, Dormers Wells High School (DWHS) and Dormers Wells Junior School (DWJS) converted to academy status and formed a multi academy trust (Dormers Wells Learning Trust, DWLT).
