Dear Parents/Carers,

Re: Coronavirus update

I would like to update parents/carers following this evening's announcement from the Prime Minister: if anyone has a cough or fever then the whole household must isolate for fourteen days. If this affects your household it is imperative that your child does not attend school during this time. Parents/carers should communicate the specific reason when reporting the absence. Staff have been told that, should any student show symptoms of a fever and/or continuous cough, the student should be isolated and parents/guardians will be expected to collect them promptly.

The school will be open as usual on Wednesday 18th March 2020. However, as the week progresses, it is likely that the school will have higher than typical staff absence and therefore a partial closure for students may have to be considered in the near future. Examination groups will be given priority and I will notify parents/guardians in advance of any such decision.

More information on resources and remote learning will be shared over the coming days.

The government advice continues to promote the importance of handwashing and the premises team will ensure the school remains thoroughly cleaned.
