Introduction to Black History Month for parents/carers

This interactive whistle stop presentation is a potted history of Black Peoples' presence in the United Kingdom starting from the Roman Empire and incorporating the Tudor, Georgian, Victorian eras and the arrival of the Windrush generation up to the present day.

The presentation includes aspects of British race relations and its impact on Black and White communities and covers the race riots in the 1950's and the national uprising during the 1980's.

Lateral Flow Testing

As you will be aware from our previous newsletter, we as a school have worked incredibly hard to develop and staff the provision of in-school lateral flow testing. This is successfully up and running with staff and students who are currently regularly on-site during this period.

This has been a large logistical task, but one that we are very proud of. We are fully aware that the government have paused on "serial testing" each day as a means to avoid self-isolation but still support, as do we, the mass testing of all students before they return to school which we are still planning for.

We believe this will reassure both staff and students and enable the site to be as safe as is reasonably possible. To do this it is essential that we have consent from all families ahead of time. We would like to take this opportunity to thank to all the families who have already given their consent for their children to take part in school lateral flow testing.
