Please see the example's below:

Student A:	Chooses the English option to the London Dungeons, this student must pay at the time of selection to secure the place. Student A can then pick the free option from English OR any other option for Day 2 <u>except London Dungeons again</u> . If this OPTION requires further payment, then this will need to be made at the time of selection to secure that place.
Student B:	Student B wishes to select the free art option for day 1 and the free Computing option for day 2. This is perfectly fine.
Student C:	Student C wishes to take part in the PE Olympics on day 1, this student must then select an option from a <u>different curriculum area</u> for Day 2 because you cannot pick the same activity twice. The chosen option can be a free option or paid option.

- You will not be able to go on the same trip 2 days in a row. Choose 2 different options for Day 1 and Day 2 to avoid disappointment.
- Numbers are limited on some activities and places will be offered on a first come, first served basis.
- No cash will be accepted.
- Students will not be able to participate in activities unless full payment has been made.
- Participation in any school activity is dependent on good attendance, good punctuality, good behaviour and the ability to follow the rules and guidelines of the school.
- As with any school activity students must follow the instructions of school staff and must behave in a responsible manner at all times to ensure the health and safety of themselves and those around them.


From P1-P4 students will create the products and practice.P5 is the Fashion show/Music/Photography

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Create a Clay Pot

Spend a day in the Art department investigating then making your own ceramic vessel inspired by natural forms. You will explore themes such as life and death, sea-life or flight and create a digital mood board. This will then help you to design your own unique artwork using clay. This is a fantastic opportunity to use fun and exciting materials and be able to spend uninterrupted time making an artwork. Become an expert in working with clay and how to describe what you are making. At the end of the session your work will be fired in the kiln and can then be taken home at the end of the school year.



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Students visiting businesses

Have an interest in Business and Economics? We have an exciting opportunity to visit real companies and explore what a “day in the life” looks like for people working there.

You will get to see how different departments operate, take part in hands-on tasks and activities, and learn directly from employees about their roles. These visits include a workplace tour, an interactive group activity linked to real job roles, and the chance to ask questions and learn about different career pathways. Previous employer partners have included Novotel, Newmark, Mace, Volker Fitzpatrick and JCDecaux. The final visiting company will be confirmed in late March.

After the trip, you should have a deeper understanding of different sectors and local employers, helping to raise your career aspirations, confidence and awareness of future opportunities.

Why don't pilots die? Through taking part in experiments and getting to grips with real flight equipment, your students will discover the potentially lethal effects of changing air pressure, examine heat transfers and their effects on flight crews and explore how pilots can train their bodies to fight high G-Forces.

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Robot workshop

Students will learn to program and control a Micro:Bit Cutebot—a microcontroller-based robotic car—using Python. The enrichment program will guide participants through the basics of coding, from setting up the Micro:Bit to implementing advanced functionality for controlling the Cutebot. By working in teams or individually, students will design and program their robotic cars to navigate a custom-designed track.

The program will culminate in an exciting competition where students showcase their programming skills. Participants will compete to see whose Cutebot can complete the track most efficiently, avoiding obstacles and achieving specific objectives.
