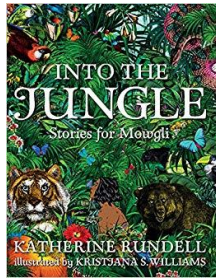


## Year 6/7 Summer Reading Activity 2021
