

AVAILABLE OPTIONS

- Business studies will not be offered as an option this year.
- Students who have not studied business studies at GCSE are not disadvantaged when they start the subject at Year 12.
- Many universities (including Russell Group) do not require you to have A Level Business before starting an Accounting, Business or Management course.
- Separate sciences will be available as an option for students in science sets 1 to 4.
