# OPPORTUNITIES

## NATIONAL APPRENTICESHIP WEEK

National Apprenticeship Week is an annual week-long celebration of apprenticeships across England. We run a series of scheduled events across the school at that time. A number of our students are interested in, and successfully move onto, a range of apprenticeships. Please get in touch if you would like to promote apprenticeship opportunities to our students.

## NATIONAL CAREERS WEEK

National Careers Week is an annual week-long celebration of different careers. We run a series of scheduled events across the school at that time. Please get in touch if you would like to run a specific talk or event with students.

## WINTER CAREERS CONFERENCE

This is a careers fair set up in a free flowing stall based format. Students aged 14-18 visit the fair to meet employers, universities, colleges and apprenticeship providers to find out about different opportunities available to them. You can get involved by having a booth or table, and having your employees talking to students about their work and the opportunities your organisation can provide.

## SUMMER CAREERS CONFERENCE

This careers conference takes place in a speed dating format. Students aged between 11 and 13 meet with employers, universities, colleges and apprenticeship providers to find out more about day to day working life and different educational pathways available. Your employees can get involved by talking to students about their work and the opportunities your organisation can provide.

## MOCK INTERVIEW DAY

Students experience the opportunity of a formal interview with a person from industry. This allows them to dress in their formal best, practicing their professional body language and selling their skills set to an employer. You can get involved by adding your branding to raise the profile of your company, and interviewing a set of students, providing them feedback to ensure they are ready for their first ever real world job interview.

## A DAY IN THE LIFE OF...

Helping students understand niche careers, or the wide variety of roles available in a sector is crucial. This is an ongoing series of talks, aimed at helping students understand what a range of different job roles look like in different industries. These talks take place from 3:30-4:15 either in person, or online. Contact us to help organise a time when you can speak to students about why your job is the best career choice for them!

## POST-16 AND POST-18 OPTIONS

Under the requirements of Provider Access Legislation, we are happy to share opportunities for students at the end of Years 11 and 13. Our students are keen to hear from colleges, universities, and apprenticeship providers. This can be in assemblies, or as part of a more bespoke event. In addition, organisations are welcome to attend our Year 11 and Sixth form focus evenings (held in September), and our Tertiary Taster Day (held in January). Assemblies take place between 8:45 and 9:15.



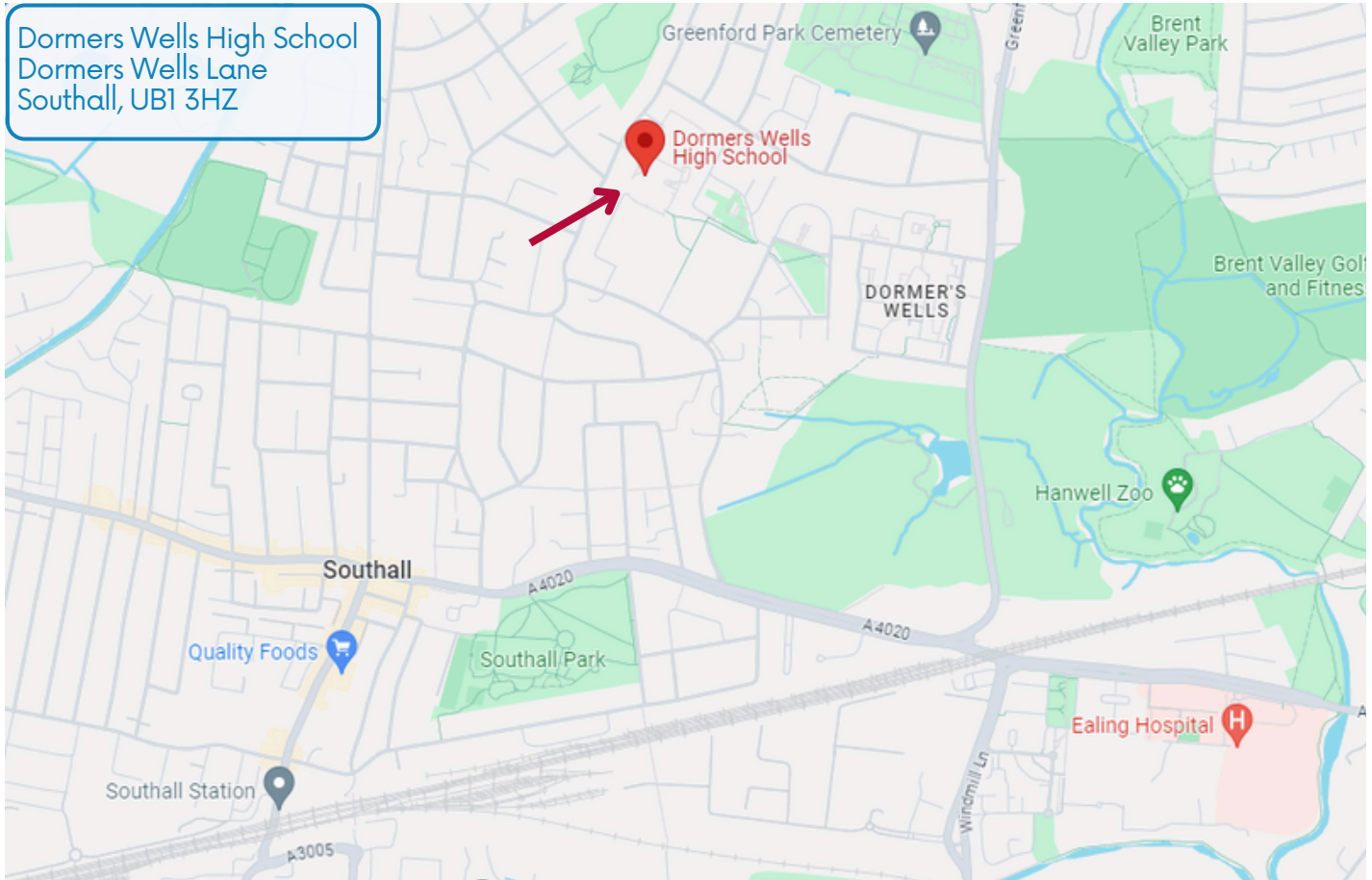
